PLEASE NOTE: Any Group receiving a time slot at the District 25 Meeting were not eligible to draw at the Intergroup Meeting!

There were 18 1-hour time slots available for each District 25 Alcathon at each Meeting—and slips for each slot were placed in a bowl to be drawn. All eligible attendees drew from the bowl—but blank slips were added to the bowl in the event that more than 18 eligible attendees were in attendance. If a group drew a blank slip at the District 25 Meeting, that Group was eligible to try for a slot at the Intergroup Meeting. Several unfilled slots are listed with the Intergroup Office; any group representative may call and the office will assign a slot on their behalf.

Tradition Eleven (Long Form)

Our names and pictures as A.A. members ought not be broadcast, filmed, or publicly printed. Our public relations should be guided by the principle of attraction rather than promotion. There is never need to praise ourselves. We feel it better to let our friends recommend us.

"It should be the privilege, even the right, of each individual or group to handle anonymity as they wish ... Each individual will have to decide where he ought to draw the line -- how far he ought to carry the principle in his own affairs, how far he may go in dropping his own anonymity without injury to Alcoholics Anonymous as a whole."

WAI's HALTline has openings for all shifts. HALTline allows people to call the number for WAI and get a live, sober person to talk to. We are NOT a taxi service or counseling service. We DO give meeting information, talk and listen to another sober alcoholic in danger of picking up a drink, a sober alcoholic visiting the area who doesn't know anyone around here or a drunk who just needs that link in the chain to get them to go to a meeting.

One year of sobriety is suggested, along with touch-tone phone service and 3 or more hours a week to answer the phone when the office is closed.
